Course Description

This course is an expositional study of 2 Corinthians and Galatians.

Course Objectives

1. Remember the basic content and message of 2 Corinthians and Galatians.

3. Know major problem passages and their possible solutions related to 2 Corinthians and Galatians.
4. Gain a greater appreciation for the canonical contributions of 2 Corinthians and Galatians.
5. Grow in spiritual maturity through careful and consistent application of the principles found in 2 Corinthians and Galatians.

Course Assignment Description

1. Read 2 Corinthians and Galatians at least twice during the length of the course. There is no substitute for reading the Scriptures!
2. Keep a notebook (preferably a 3-ring binder) devoted *specifically* to 2 Corinthians and Galatians. The notebook should contain the course handouts, your notes, and any assignments that you do for this course. Organizing these materials now will make them accessible in the future as you continue your studies and as you may have opportunity to teach the book.
